## CHILD CARE HOME - Annual Training - PRIMARY CAREGIVER

The State of TEXAS requires primary caregivers to obtain at least 30 clock-hours of training each year. These include:

- 1.) 80% (24 Hours) MAY be obtained from self-instructional sources (such as online training available HERE through Impact Training Center).
- 2.) 20% (6 hours) MUST be obtained from interactive sources (ie. Face to face class, webinar, or similiar)

PLEASE NOTE: The above annual training clock hours DO NOT INCLUDE any requirements for: orientation, pre-service training, CPR and first aid training, transportation safety training, and high school
