Texas Child Care Center - 24 Clock Hrs of **Annual Training-Caregiver**

General Clock Hour Requirements:

The state of TEXAS requires each caregiver in Child Care Centers to obtain at least 24 clock-hours of **ANNUAL TRAINING** each year relevant to the age of the children they provide care for. These hours include:

- 1) 80% (19 hours) MAY be obtained using trainings from a self-instructional source (such as the online training currently offered through Impact Training Center).
- 2) 20% (5 hours) MUST be obtained from an interactive source (ie. Face to face class, webinar or similar.)

PLEASE NOTE: The 24 clock hours of annual training **DO NOT INCLUDE** any requirements for orientation, pre-service training, CPR and first aid training, transportation safety training, and high school child-care work-study classes.
