Texas Child Care Center - 24 Clock Hours of <u>Caregiver Pre-Service</u>

General Clock Hour Requirements:

The state of TEXAS requires each caregiver in Child Care Centers to obtain <u>at least 24 clock-hours</u> of **PRE-SERVICE TRAINING** each year relevant to the age of the children they provide care for.

These hours include:

- A.) <u>8 clock-hours</u> training **BEFORE** caregiver may be counted in the child/caregiver ratio.
- B.) 16 clock-hours of training WITHIN 90 days of employment.

Caregivers can be <u>EXEMPT</u> from pre-service training requirement if they:

- A.) Have at least 2 years prior experience in a regulated child care center;
- B.) Have documentation of 24 clock-hours of pre-service training
