# Texas Registered & Licensed Child Care Homes - <u>Annual Training - Caregiver</u>

## **General Clock Hour Requirements:**

The State of TEXAS requires caregivers in **Registered Homes** to obtain at least **15 clock-hours** of training each year. Licensed Homes must obtain at least 24 clock-hours of training each year. These include:

- 1.) 80% (12 hrs for Registered Homes and 19 Hours for Licensed Homes) MAY be obtained from self-instructional sources (such as the online training currently available at Impact Training Center).
- 2.) 20% (3 hours for Registered Homes and 5 Hours for Licensed Homes) MUST be obtained from interactive sources (ie. Face to face class, webinar, or similiar)
- PLEASE NOTE: The above annual training clock hours DO NOT INCLUDE any requirements for: orientation, pre-service training, CPR and first aid training, transportation safety training, and high school child-care work-study classes.
