

CHILD CARE HOME - Annual Training - CAREGIVER

The State of TEXAS requires caregivers in **Registered Homes** to obtain at least **15 clock-hours** of training each year. **Licensed Homes** must obtain at least **24 clock-hours** of training each year. These include:

- 1.) 80% (12 hrs for Registered Homes and 19 Hours for Licensed Homes) **MAY** be obtained from self-instructional sources (such as the online training available [HERE at Impact Training Center](#)).
- 2.) 20% (3 hours for Registered Homes and 5 Hours for Licensed Homes) **MUST** be obtained from interactive sources (ie. Face to face class, webinar, or similiar)
