Texas Child Care Center - 30 Clock Hrs of Annual Training-Director

General Clock Hour Requirements:

- A.) Each caregiver must obtain at least 30 clock-hours of training each year.
- B.) Up to 80% of the annual training (24 Hours) may be obtained from self-instructional training.

A.) At least 6 clock-hours of training from one or more of the following categories:

C.) The 30 clock-hours of annual training are exclusive of any requirements for orientation; pre-service; CPR & First Aid Training; Transportation Safety Training; and high school child care work study classes.

<u>A director with five or fewer years of experience</u> as a child care center director must complete at least 6 hours of annual training in management techniques, leadership, or staff supervision. <u>A director with more than</u> 5 years experience must complete 3 hours of annual training in these area's.TX-DR-PA
